ELIGIBILITY FOR ABSENTEE BALLOT

A person is eligible for an absentee ballot if such person is or will be on the date of the election:

- a) A patient in a hospital or unable to appear personally at the polling place on such day because of illness or physical disability; *or*
- b) Because a person's duties, occupation, business or studies will require such person to be outside of the County of Nassau on such day; *or*
- c) Because such person will be absent from his voting residence because he is detained in jail, awaiting action by a Grand Jury or awaiting trial, or is confined to prison after conviction for an offense other than a felony.

PLEASE NOTE: The District Clerk of the Oyster Bay-East Norwich Central School District is entitled, by law, to have further information supplied in application as he/she shall deem reasonable and necessary in order to make a judgment as to whether application is entitled to an Absentee Ballot.

SPECIAL INFORMATION REQUIRED

1. Where such duties, occupation, or business are of such a nature as ordinarily to require such absence, please give a brief description of such duties, occupation, or business in the space provided in the Application for an Absentee Ballot. Where such duties, occupation, or business are not of such a nature as ordinarily to require such absence, please give a statement of the special circumstances on account of which the absence is required in this particular instance.
2. If applicant expects in good faith to be absent on the date of the election because he/she will be away on vacation, please set for the dates of which the vacation is expected to begin and end, the place or places where he/she expects to be on such vacation, and the name and address of his/her employer, if any, or if self-employed, a statement to that effect.
3. Where the absence is because of detention or confinement to jail, please state whether the voter is detained or awaiting action of the Grand Jury or is confined after conviction for an offense other than a felony.

If applicant is the spouse, parent, or child of a qualified voter entitled to vote by Absentee Ballot for any of the foregoing reasons, then the application should clearly state that the absence from the school district is because of the fact that applicant is accompanying such person who will be absent from the school district for any of the foregoing reasons.
