<b>The Walden Environmental Engineering Award</b>	<p>Students must propose a scheme that will limit the pollution in stormwater runoff into Oyster Bay, which often results in the NYS Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) closing shellfish beds for harvesting.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Identify why excess stormwater runoff occurs, what measures can be taken to address this problem &amp; limit the number of shellfish closure days in a specific waterway.</li> <li>• Describe in detail what current permits exist in the municipality to address water quality, how those permits are affected by stormwater events, what local agencies do to address the problem immediately and what your proposal is for a long-term solution.</li> <li>• Your solution may include, for example, the construction of new infrastructure or the installation of equipment to monitor water levels. You may also include proposals to treat water, such as using swirl separators, which use gravity to remove waste and other debris from stormwater runoff.
